

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FB3 TUBE REAR DOORS 2021-24 BRONCO 4-DOOR PART#TRDFB21


PROCEDURE: REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED.


- 1. Start installation at the driver/left rear door. Unplug the wiring harness leading to the door, (Figure 1).
- 2. Remove the hardware attaching the top and bottom hinges to the door frame and remove the door, (Figures 1 & 2). Refer to owner's manual for full door removal instructions.
- 3. Carefully unwrap the driver/left Tubular Door assembly. Select (1) Rubber Bumper. Attach the Rubber Bumper to the threaded hole in the top corner of the door with the included (1) 4mm Button Head Screw and (1) 4mm Flat Washers, (Figure 3). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.


- Select the driver/left Latch Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the Door Assembly with the included (2) 6mm x 25mm Button Head Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers and (2) 6mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 4 & 5). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- Attach the driver/left Latch Assembly to the outside of the Mounting Bracket with the included (2) 6mm x 25mm Button Head Bolts, (2) 6mm Lock Washers and (2) 6mm Flat Washers, (Figure 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- Select the driver/left Upper Hinge Assembly, (Figure 7). Attach the Hinge Assembly to the outside of the mounting tab on the Door Assembly with the included (2) 8mm x 25mm Button Head Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers, (2) 8mm Flat Washers and (1) 8mm Double Nut Plate, (Figure 7). Do not fully tighten hardware.
- Next, select the driver/left Lower Hinge Bracket, (Figure 8). Attach the Bracket to the outside of the lower mounting tab on the Door Assembly with the included (2) 8mm x 25mm Button Head Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers, (2) 8mm Flat Washers and (1) 8mm Double Nut Plate, (Figure 8). Do not fully tighten hardware.
- Select (1) Tall Nylon Upper Tube Spacer, (Figure 9). Place the Tube Spacer over the sleeve in the upper hinge mount, (Figure 10). Select (1) Steel Lower Tube Spacer, (Figure 9). Place the Tube Spacer over the lower hinge mount on the door frame, (Figure 11).
- 9. Carefully hold the door in place over the hinges on the vehicle. Guide the Upper Hinge Pin down and into the hinge and Tall Tube Spacer. Secure the Hinge Pin to the hinge with (1) 6mm Flat Washer, (1) 6mm Lock Washer and (1) 6mm Hex Nut, (Figure 12). Leave Hex Nut loose at this time.
- 10. Attach the bottom Hinge Bracket to the top of the lower hinge and Tube Spacer with the included (1) 8mm x 25mm Hex Bolt, (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm x 25mm Flat Washer, (Figure 12). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- **11.**Open and close the door a few times to center the hinge pins in the hinges. Center the Door assembly in the opening in the vehicle. Adjust as necessary and fully tighten Hinge to Door hardware only.
- **12.** Place the included 6mm Flat Washers between the Rubber Bumper and the Tube Door to adjust the Door in or out as necessary, **(Figure 13)**.
- **13.** Adjust the position of the Latch assembly outward in the slots as far as possible. Snug but do not fully tighten hardware. Slowly close the door and check to see if the Latch is lined up with the center of the striker. Insert the included Thick and/or Thin Shims as necessary between the Latch and the Bracket to line up Latch with striker, **(Figure 14)**.
- 14. Adjust the Latch up or down to line up with striker, (Figure 15). IMPORTANT: Make sure Latch will <u>fully close and open</u> properly before fully tightening Latch hardware. Check to see that the latch fully closes then gradually move the latch in toward the door to tighten up the door and fully tighten all hardware, (Figure 16).


(Fig 17) Tighten hardware on Hinges (driver/left Upper Hinge pictured)

- **15.** Once Door is fully adjusted, tighten the top 6mm Hex Nut and bottom 8mm Hex Bolt hardware on the Hinges until there is slight resistance in the door operation, **(Figures 17 & 18)**.
- **16.** Repeat **Steps 1—15** to install the passenger/right Door assembly.
- **17.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Doors.


Driver/left Side Installation Pictured









Driver/left Side Installation Pictured

(Fig 15) Loosen hardware. Adjust Latch up or down to match striker
