


(2) LED Lamp Bracket




Main Body

Passenger/Right Brush Guard




Driver/Left Brush Guard



Please Noted:

1. Before you install the Grille Guard on the vehicle, please install the Driver/Left Brush Guard and Passenger/Right Brush Guard on the main body first.
2. Before you install the LED lamp on the main body please install the LED lamp bracket first.
3. If you are not going to install a LED lamp, the LED lamp bracket installation is unnecessary. For main body installation follow the instruction as bellow.



PROCEDURE:

1. **REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED. EXCLUDES ALL MODELS WITH FULL 1-PIECE PLASTIC BUMPER COVER.**
2. Determine if the vehicle is equipped with or without the factory tow hooks.
On vehicles without factory tow hooks: Remove the plastic fill panel on the front bumper by removing the 2-piece plastic clips at the top of the panel, **(Figure 1)**. **NOTE:** Use a flat-blade screwdriver to first pop the center pin out to release the clip. Next, from behind the driver side of the front bumper, remove the (2) hex nuts on the bottom of the bumper bracket securing the bumper to the frame, **(Figure 2)**.
On vehicles with factory tow hooks: Start the installation on the driver side, behind the front bumper. Remove the factory tow hook, **(Figure 3)**. Remove the two hex nuts on the bottom of the bumper bracket securing the 2-bolt tow hook mounting bracket to the frame.
3. Next, drive the (2) carriage bolts in the bumper bracket out of the bracket by striking the end of the bolts with a hammer, **(Figure 4)**. Discard the tin retaining washers. Insert the driver side Mounting Bracket into the opening in the front of the bumper. Line up the (2) mounting holes with the holes in the bumper bracket. Insert (2) 12mm x 60mm Hex Bolts and (2) 12mm x 32mm OD Large Flat Washers through the driver side Frame Mounting Bracket and bumper bracket. Use the supplied (2) 12mm x 24mm Flat Washers, (2) 12mm Lock Washers and (2) 12mm Hex Nuts, **(Figures 5 & 6)**. Snug but do not tighten hardware.

On vehicles with factory tow hooks: Reinstall the factory 2-bolt tow hook bracket and secure with the supplied (2) 12mm x 24mm Flat Washers, (2) 12mm Lock Washers and (2) 12mm Hex Nuts. Snug but do not tighten hardware at this time. Reinstall the tow hook using the factory hardware.

4. Repeat **Steps 2 & 3** to install the passenger/right Frame Bracket.
5. Next, determine the correct procedure for your model year.

2009-12 Models:

- a. Carefully pull up on the plastic bumper cover, (on top of the bumper), to locate the carriage bolt securing the top of the steel bumper to the inner bumper bracket. Remove the carriage bolt, (**Figures 7 & 8**). **NOTE:** Use a socket with extension to reach the hex nut on the carriage bolt from behind the bumper. Access the hex nut from above the bumper bracket, (**Figure 7**).
- b. Attach the driver side 09-12 Top Mounting Bracket to the bumper by inserting (1) 10mm x 40mm Hex Bolt and (1) 10mm Flat Washer through the Bracket and hole in the bumper, (**Figures 9 & 10**). Secure with (1) 10mm Flat Washer, (1) 10mm Lock Washer and (1) 10mm Hex Nut. Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- c. Repeat **Steps a & b** for passenger side Upper Bracket installation.

2013-16 Models:




(Fig 11) driver side 2013-16 model pictured

- a. Remove the plastic fascia cover from the top of the bumper, (**Figure 11**).




(Fig 14) driver side 2013-16 Upper Bracket




(Fig 13) Insert driver side 2013-16 Upper Bracket between tab on inner bumper bracket and top of bumper

 - b. Lift up on the plastic inner cover to locate the top bumper bolt, (**Figure 14**). Remove the bolt and clip nut. Insert the driver side 2013-16 Upper Bracket between the tab on the inner bumper bracket and the top of the bumper, (**Figure 13**).
 - c. Insert (1) 10mm Nut Plate into the slot in the top of the bumper. Line up the Nut Plate with the holes in the Upper Bracket and the inner bumper bracket. Attach the Upper Bracket to the Nut Plate with (1) 10mm x 40mm Hex Bolt, (1) 10mm Lock Washer and (1) 10mm Flat Washer inserted down through the tab on the factory bumper bracket, the Upper Bracket, the bumper and into the Nut Plate, (**Figure 12—14**). Do not fully tighten at this time.
 - d. Repeat **Steps a—c** for passenger side Upper Bracket installation.
 - e. Reinstall the plastic fascia cover on the top of the bumper but leave loose.
6. With assistance, position the Grille Guard up to the Frame Mounting Brackets and on top of the Upper Mounting Brackets. Use the included (4) 12mm x 35mm Hex Bolts, (8) 12mm STD Flat Washers, (4) 12mm Lock Washers and (4) 12mm Hex Nuts to attach the Grille Guard to the Frame Mounting Brackets, (**Figure 15**). Snug but do not tighten at this time.
 7. Attach the Grille Guard to the Upper Brackets using the included (2) 12mm x 35mm Hex Bolts, (4) 12mm STD Flat Washers, (2) 12mm Lock Washers and (2) 12mm Hex Nuts, (**Figures 16—19**). Snug but do not tighten hardware at this time.




(Fig 20) driver side headlight assembly




(Fig 21) driver side Top Support Bracket

 8. Next, open the hood. Locate and remove the inner top mounting screw attaching the headlight assembly to the radiator cross member, (**Figure 20**). Select the driver side Top Support Bracket. Insert the Support Bracket between the tab on the headlight and the cross member. Reuse the factory screw to attach the Support Bracket, (**Figure 21**).
 9. Line up the Support Bracket with the (2) mounting holes in the bottom of the headlight guard. Attach the Bracket to the Grille Guard with (2) 8mm Button Head Screws, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat washers, (**Figures 22 & 23**). Do not fully tighten at this time.
 10. Repeat **Steps 8 & 9** to attach the passenger side Top Support Bracket.
 11. With assistance, align and adjust the Grille Guard and tighten all hardware including the Top Mounting Bracket and tow hook hardware. **IMPORTANT:** On **2013-16 models**, finish reattaching the plastic fascia cover to the bumper after Upper Bracket to bumper hardware has been adjusted and fully tightened.
 12. **On vehicles without factory tow hooks:** The plastic fill panel in the front bumper removed in **Step 2** may be discarded or can be reinstalled but will require cutting to clear the Frame Mounting Brackets. Once modified, use the factory hardware to reinstall.
 13. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.


To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

EXCLUDES MODELS WITH 1-PIECE PLASTIC BUMPER COVER


For stainless steel: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Grille Guard.

For gloss black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Grille Guard





Pry up center pin with a flat blade screwdriver to release factory clip. Remove entire clip




Remove tow hook, (2) factory hex nuts and tow hook bracket







Driver Side Installation Pictured







(Fig 10) driver side 2009-12 model pictured



(Fig 12) driver side 2013-16 Upper Bracket




